Rev Brian Halfpenny

Former members of St. Luke's will be sorry to hear that Rev, Brian Halfpenny passed away on Wednesday 8th May at the age of 87.

Brian was vicar of St. Luke's for 10 years and Team Rector for the then Ridge Team of churches until his retirement in April 2001. He and Hazel retired to Bourton on the Water.

For most of his ministry Brian was a chaplain in the Royal Air Force, rising to become Chaplain-in Chief before his retirement from the RAF, aged 55. As Chaplain in Chief he became a Chaplain to the Queen and also was honoured as a Companion of the Order of the Bath.
